### Reflection of the Week by Fr. Leo Ahanotu

The readings of today hinge on life after death. We come from God, and through death, we go back to God. Death is only a movement back to God. The brothers we encounter in the first reading of today encourage us to have a strong belief in life after death. Believing in a life after death, they were not afraid to face martyrdom.

In the Gospel, Christ uses the questions of the Sadducees to renew His teachings on life after death, where God will be with us forever, and joy will be eternal. Through the answer to the Sadducees, Christ reminds us that everything we do in this world ends in this world, but the way we do them determines whether we might have a place in heaven. Let us, therefore, try our best to live our life as recommended by Christ in order to continue our life in heaven after enjoying our life here on earth. With St. Christogonus, let us remember that "God is faithful. He has promised us salvation, but as He said, He will do so on one condition – that we love Him, that we listen to His word and His Law. He will not save us unless we cooperate".

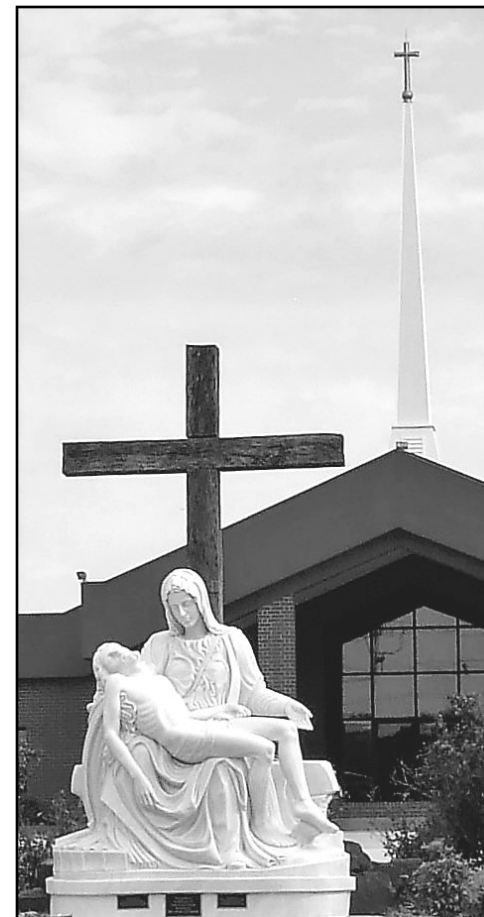
