Reflection of the Week by Fr. Leo Ahanotu

Pope Benedict XVI once expressed that appropriate wisdom does never ignore consequences and seeks for better outcomes. Wisdom goes beyond the question, "can we," to the question, "should we." The question "should we" always guided the Magi. The question made them abandon every other thing they had to do for what they should do because of its importance – searching for the Baby Jesus. They also wondered if they should go back to Herold. By the grace of God, they got the right answer of not going back because of the evil thoughts of Herold to kill the Baby Jesus and did what they should do - staying away from Herold. When I think of the actions of the magi, I question my actions and ask myself if my actions are guided by faith and if I am a person who puts thoughts and faith together all the time to be a wise person. Does my wisdom lead me to seek the Lord, and to sing the praises of the Lord as indicated in the first reading? Pope Benedict also re-echoed the Biblical passage that the knowledge of faith is not contrary to true wisdom. Like the Magi, may our wisdom or understandings be informed by faith and show us the way to God.
