Reflection of the Week by Fr. Leo Ahanotu

The readings of today remind us that we have the capacity for the goodness that can bring people to God. We have both the hands that can care and the hearts that can love, and we are the disciples of Christ entrusted with the duty of using the blessings we have to win souls for Christ. St. Paul invites us in the second reading to use all the blessings we have to initiate the work of God, and God will use His power to finish up the job. Paul's invitation tallies with the first reading from the Prophet, Isaiah, that invites us to live a life of justice and have a concern for the needs of the people around us, so that they may see God through our good actions. Jesus calls us the salt of the earth and the light of the world in the gospel. When we look at the two words, "salt and light" as allegories, we will notice that just as salt seasons or preserves food, and light dispels darkness, we are called to preserve and season the world with good morals and the teachings of Christ, and be the light that dispels the darkness of evil in the world. Today's world needs people that idolize God. Our cities need us to be the light of the cities, and Christ requires us to preserve the world with our good deeds, which has the power to turn ungodly hearts to God. Finally, let us remember that we can only give what we have, and so can only be the light of Christ to others, if we have Christ in us. *Fr. Leo*
