The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

On this day, like every Sunday, we repeat the celebration that forges our identity and strengthens us to be the very body of Christ that we receive. The Eucharist is the Real Presence of Christ and is often referred to as the "source and summit of the Church." In receiving this "sacrament of sacraments," our Savior comes not simply to meet us but into us, fills us with himself, and sanctifies us with his own supernatural, divine life in order to transform us into his likeness. In consuming the Eucharist, "the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us" (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*, 47).
By his Real Presence in the Eucharist, Christ fulfills his promise to be with us "always, until the end of the age" (Mt 28:20). Christ has not left us without his bodily presence in our pilgrimage, but he joins us to himself in this sacrament in the reality of his body and blood." (*Summa Theologiae*, III q. 75, a. 1).

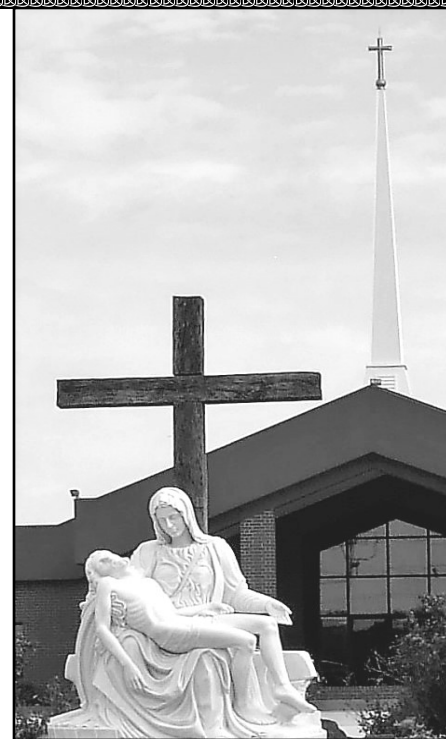
