Sunday's Reflection: In today's gospel, Jesus asserts that he is the Good Shepherd, and that he knows his sheep and they know him. The biblical meaning of the word *know* is related to the intimacy of the marriage covenant, in which one "knows" the other so intimately, that one is willing to give all for the other, even one's life. But Jesus's love is not exclusive rather is inclusive as we heard in the reading "I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd." His mission is to search them out and manifest his love, so that all may be one in him. By our baptism, we are called to be missionary disciples following the step of the Good Shepherd who came in search for the lost sheep. This way we can all experience God's redemptive love.

Reflexión dominical: En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús afirma que él es el Buen Pastor, y que conoce a sus ovejas y ella lo conocen. El significado bíblico de la palabra *conozco* está relacionado con la intimidad del convenio matrimonial, en el que uno "conoce" al otro tan íntimamente, que uno está dispuesto a dar todo por el otro, incluso la vida de uno. Pero el amor de Jesús no es exclusivo más bien inclusivo, como escuchamos en la lectura "Tengo además otras ovejas que no son de este retil y es necesario que las traiga también a ellas; escucharán mi voz y habrá un solo rebaño y un solo pastor." Su misión es buscarlas y manifestar su amor, para que todos sean uno en él. Por nuestro bautismo, estamos llamados a ser discípulos misioneros siguiendo los pasos del Buen Pastor que vino en busca de las ovejas perdidas. De esta manera todos podremos experimentar el amor redentor de Dios.
