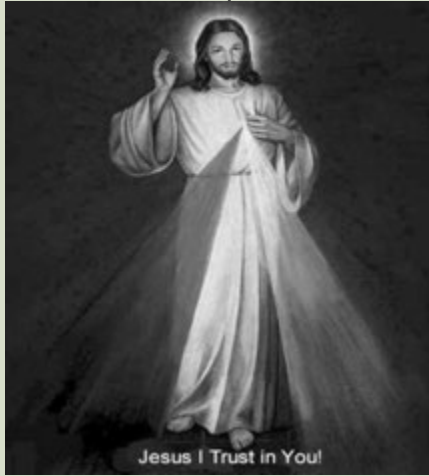

**How to Raise a Gen Z Kid
(Mid-1990s-Mid-2000s)**

Tip#4. Generation Z can handle more responsibility than they're given.

Although Gen Zers aren't as coddled as their Millennial brethren, they've led somewhat sheltered lives. Parents, laden with fears that the world is dangerous, have instilled in their children a desire to play it safe. Certainly, this is positive when considering that Generation Z is "just saying no" to drugs, but it has its downside when it removes adult-style responsibility from the child's world. Introduce new duties systematically to preteens and teens, such as asking them to phone in an order to a restaurant — rather than using the eatery's website — or negotiate a deal on merchandise they want to buy. These tasks may not seem earth-shattering, but they have a cumulative effect on a child's ability to develop business and common sense.

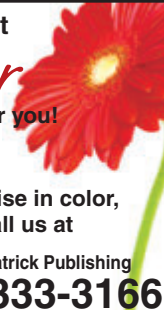

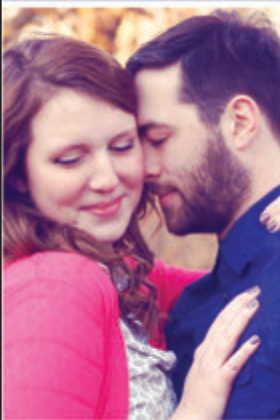
