The purpose of a Mass Intention is to hold up to the Lord a particular individual or group in addition to the intentions that are included in the celebration of every Eucharist: for the Holy Father, the archdiocesan bishop, the clergy, and “the entire people your Son has gained for you” (EP III). Those named in the Mass intention, be they living or dead, participate in a special way in the grace of the Eucharistic sacrifice. When requesting a Mass intention, it is customary to make an offering. With this offering, the faithful “contribute to the good of the church and by their offering take part in the concern of the church for the support of its ministers and work.” (Canon 946)

Please note that if you are unable to get your preferred date, your Mass intention request can be sent to the Archdiocesan Mission Office.

Please fill out the form on the back for all Mass intentions. A \$10 stipend for each Mass Intention requested is to accompany the form.

**Mass Intention Policy**

- A maximum of 12 Masses may be scheduled per household each calendar year.
- A maximum of 4 can be for a weekend or Holy Day Mass.
- A weekend Mass intention will not be taken for the same person more than once in the same calendar month.
- A weekday Mass intention will not be taken for the same person more than once in the same week. (Weekend Mass—Friday)
- If no specific date/time is requested, please indicate that with “Any”.
- Mass intentions will **not** be accepted for:
  - The three days of the Sacred Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday or Holy Saturday
  - Christmas Eve and Day, Easter, Mother’s Day, Memorial Day, Father’s Day and All Saints or All Souls Day. (These Mass intentions will be for the general intentions of our priests and parishioners.)
  - The Sunday in January reserved for Catholic Schools Week and the Mass celebrated for our school. (Date varies - usually the 3rd or 4th Sunday.)
- Mass requests will be granted as close to the requested date and time as possible.
- We reserve the right to change dates to accommodate the needs of the parish.
- Requests will be honored on a **first-come, first served** basis in the order in which the form or request is received at the Parish Office.

## Mass Intentions requested for July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020

**Mass Intentions will not be taken for:** Parish Festival Weekend, All Saints Day—Nov. 1; All Soul's Day—Nov.2; Christmas Eve and Christmas Day; Catholic Schools Week Sunday in January (date varies—usually the 3rd or 4th Sunday); Triduum—Easter, April 9-April 12; Mother's Day—May 10; Memorial Day—May 25, or Father's Day—June 21.
