We here at Santo Nino are pleased to offer you & your child(ren) a unique and memorable summer day camp experience beginning June 14th and ending July 23rd; no camp on July 2nd, 2021. Our camp is available to children entering **Pre-Kinder (4 years old) through 8th grade**. Our mission is to provide a program with a variety of learning and fun that nurture curiosity, confidence and a love of learning.

We are committed to offering our campers an enjoyable and enriching summer experience in a physically safe, emotionally supportive, and fun-filled environment. We believe our high-quality instruction and cheerful faculty create the perfect environment for exploration, growth, and most of all the fun. Whether it's for a few weeks, or full-time, Santo Nino's summer program is sure to provide just what you need.

Children may be dropped off between 8:00-8:30 A.M. Camp will begin each morning 8:30 A.M. and will end promptly at 5:00 P.M. A non-refundable (unless program is cancelled by school officials) deposit fee of **\$60.00 per student**. The fee for camp is **\$160.00 per week, per child**. A late fee of \$15 will be charged for late pick-ups at 5:00 P.M.

All fees **MUST** be paid prior to the week your child will be attending.

Parents will need to provide their children with the following:


- Lunch
- Two healthy snacks (one for the morning, one for the afternoon)
- Water Bottle
- A light jacket or sweater
- Hat
- Change of clothes
- A good pair of tennis shoes (Flip flops, sandals, crocs, and other forms of open-toed shoes and shoes without backs are dangerous in a school environment and are **NOT ALLOWED**)
- A blanket, pillow, small mat, and two full changes of clothes for Per-Kinder students are required.
- Please sunscreen your child prior to dropping them off and bring sunscreen to be added when necessary.

** All belongings **MUST** be labeled with your child's name on them. The Santo Nino Summer Program is not responsible for items that are not properly labeled. **

Our summer program is dependent upon the statewide Health Order from the New Mexico Department of Health (NMDOH) and the Governor's office.
