

Grade 4 – Chapter Schedule

Each week, the parent and child should work together studying the Chapter in the textbook. When completed, follow the schedule for that week's requirements.

When your child is assigned work to be sent to me, the student is to **"hand-write"** their answers, then submit the completed assignment to me by either scanning the assignment and emailing to homeschool@corpuschristipgh.org or taking a photo and texting (724-747-5959) it to me. **Be sure to include your child's name so I can give him/her credit.**

Be sure to review what the Trinity is with your parents (One God in three persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.) |
| Oct. 18 | Chapter 6 – Do not complete the eAssessment ... instead complete questions 16, 17, 19, and 20 on page 119 from the textbook – These answers are to be "handwritten" by the student and sent to me as described above |
| Oct. 25 | Chapter 7 eAssessment
Also, as a family, discuss Intercession prayers (petitions) where you ask God for something for another person or for the community. (see page 126) |
| Nov. 1 | All Saints' Day – This is a special day Catholics practice celebrating all those who have entered Heaven, including saints who are recognized by the Church and those who are not. (There are people who have lived a saintly life, but have not had the recognition of "saint" by the church; however, through the eyes of God, they are saints.)
Since this is a Holy Day of Obligation this year, take a break from your lesson and pray to your favorite saint, asking this saint to intercede (to pray with you to Jesus) your prayer requests. |

| Nov. 20 | Let's prepare for Thanksgiving by thanking someone special!
