

## Grade 6 – Chapter Schedule

| Nov. 13  | Chapter 9 – Do not complete the eAssessment ... instead Complete questions 16, 17, and 18 on page 153 and send to me (must be <u>handwritten</u> by student)   |
| Nov. 20  | Let's prepare for Thanksgiving by thanking someone special! Write that person a letter (handwritten by student) expressing why you are thankful for them. Be sure to include the reasons why you appreciate them. <b><u>DO NOT SUBMIT THIS TO ME.</u></b> This is between you and that special person.   |
| Nov. 27  | Happy Thanksgiving! Corpus Christi is thankful for each and every one of YOU! Thank you, Parents, for being an example of our Catholic faith!  |
| Nov. 29  | Read pages 15, 16, 17, 18, and 19 in your textbook. Does your family have an Advent wreath? <i>It is time to light the first purple candle.</i> You will light another candle each week. First week, purple; second week, purple, Third week, rose (pink); and fourth week, purple<br>Purple represents prayer and penance, and rose (pink) represents joy!  |

Instead, re-read page 226 and 227 because these are the three Sacraments of Initiation  
Please take time with your parents/guardians to discuss these pages in detail.
- Feb. 7 Chapter 17 eAssessment
- Feb. 14 Chapter 18 – Do not complete the eAssessment ... instead  
Answer questions 17 and 19 on page 255 and send to me
- Feb. 21 Chapter 19 – Do not complete the eAssessment ... instead  
Re-read page 261 and think about a Prayer of Intercession that you would pray  
You can ask others or Mary or Jesus or a saint(s) to intercede (listen and pray with you)  
your prayer. In the Bible in “the Book of Matthew, chapter 18, verse 2)” it reads “For  
where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.”  
Discuss this with your parents. Nothing is to be sent to me as this is between the child  
and their parents/guardians.

- Mar. 14 Pick up your Bible and open it to any page. Read something on that page and take note  
to see if you can understand it, can it relate to you and your life.
