

Grade 8 – Chapter Schedule

Each week, the parent and child should work together studying the Chapter in the textbook. When completed, follow the schedule for that week's requirements.

Nov. 1	All Saints' Day – This is a special day Catholics practice celebrating all those who have entered Heaven, including saints who are recognized by the Church and those who are not. (There are people who have lived a saintly life, but have not had the recognition of "saint" by the church; however, through the eyes of God, they are saints.) Since this is a Holy Day of Obligation this year, take a break from your lesson and pray to your favorite saint, asking this saint to intercede (to pray with you to Jesus) your prayer requests.

Nov. 13	Chapter 9 – Do not complete the eAssessment ... instead On page 169, complete questions 22 and 23 and SEND TO ME. (Again, this is to be handwritten by the student)
Nov. 20	Let's prepare for Thanksgiving by thanking someone special! Write that person a letter (handwritten by student) expressing why you are thankful for them. Be sure to include the reasons why you appreciate them. DO NOT SUBMIT THIS TO ME. This is between you and that special person.
Nov. 27	Happy Thanksgiving! Corpus Christi is thankful for each and every one of YOU! Thank you, Parents, for being an example of our Catholic faith!
Nov. 29	Read pages 22, 23, and 24 in your textbook. Does your family have an Advent wreath? <i>It is time to light the first purple candle.</i> You will light another candle each week. First week, purple; second week, purple, Third week, rose (pink); and fourth week, purple Purple represents prayer and penance, and rose (pink) represents joy!
