DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET



Saint Faustina is a Polish saint born in 1905. She later entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy where she devoted her life to prayer and caring for others. In the 1930's, Sister Faustina received a message of mercy from the Lord which she was told to spread throughout the world. This is how the prayerful devotion, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, began. Each day from Good Friday to Divine Mercy Sunday (the Sunday after Easter Sunday), the Divine Mercy novena is prayed. Please pray the Chaplet in your home each day. On Divine Mercy Sunday Adoration will be in the church beginning after the 12:30pm Mass. We will pray the Chaplet in the church with our community at 3:00pm.
