



Email clarifying 4th Degree Uniforms 082719:

Worthy Sir Knights,

At this year's Provincial meeting that concluded yesterday, 8/25/19 in Colleyville, Texas, we received further clarification on wearing the so-called "social" attire.

When wearing the "social" attire, you can dress as follows -

Dark suit with plain shirt, straight or buttoned-down collar, PG-113 or combination pin (4th Degree pin with US flag on top), black shoes, black belt, subdued color tie and a social baldric.

If wearing a black tuxedo, you may choose a plain or pleated shirt with or without cuffed sleeves. The shirt also could have straight or buttoned-down collar (wing type collar not permitted), bow or long necktie, PG-113 or combination pin (4th Degree pin with US flag on top), black shoes and a social baldric.

With regards to the official Uniform of the Fourth Degree, the requirements did not change. Please note that only the PG-113 pin is permitted on the lapel. In addition, we are not permitted to wear a name tag on the uniform blazer whether in full gear or when dressed down.

When at a wake/visitation, you cannot post by the casket unless dressed in full uniform. However, you are free to attend the wake in street clothes, Council or Assembly shirt, participate in the Rosary, approach the fallen brother to pay your respect, etc.

You also cannot be part of the honor guard when the casket is being removed from the hearse unless dressed in full uniform.

I hope that you will find these new guidelines helpful while contemplating purchasing your uniform and begin participating in the honor guard activities
