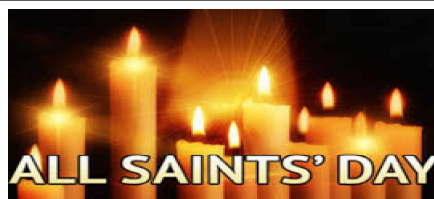
**“You will drink of the cup that I will drink . . .
