Patmos is a charming small island in the Aegean Sea between Greece and Turkey where the Book of Revelations was written by John. It is a *letter* addressed to the *Seven Churches of Asia*. John employs sinister images and applies coded references to people and groups to convey the beauty of the Love of God and to challenge disciples of Jesus to stay firm in the faith, in the face of rejection and persecution. He taught that God was not confined to a building, the temple in Jerusalem. Rather, Jesus, the Lamb, and all who believe in Him and imitate Him, are *temples*. Jesus challenged the teaching and threatened the livelihood of the Jewish leaders. He also challenges us to believe in God as the source of all that we have and all that ever will be. When we accept God's love for us and all that He has given us, and try to imitate Jesus, we must accept the consequences that may come with that.
