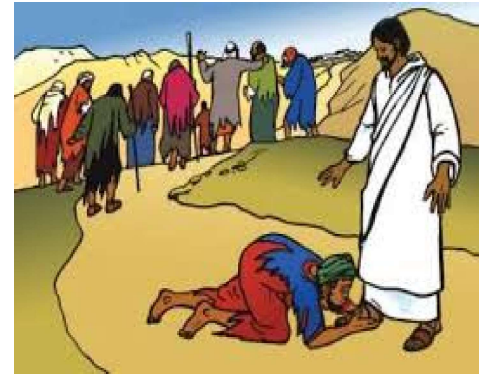


***“Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?”***
