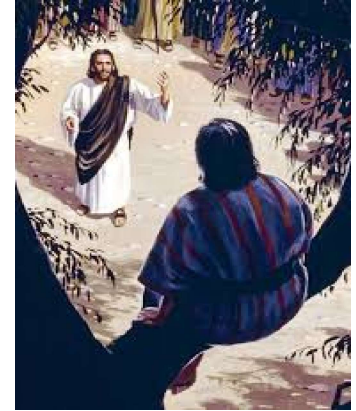


**“Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I shall give to the poor, and if I have extorted anything from anyone I shall repay it four times.”**

**MILITARY SERVICES COLLECTION – NOVEMBER 9<sup>TH</sup> & 10<sup>TH</sup>**

This collection funds the Archdiocese for the Military Services’ Co-Sponsored Seminarian Program which identifies vocations within the military and is now education 30 men for the priesthood and subsequent military chaplaincy. Currently, 285 Catholic military chaplains provide pastoral care to over 1.5 million Catholics on ships, in combat, on bases and in 153 VA hospitals. A seminarian for our diocese is participating in this program.

**REQUIRED TRAINING FOR ALL EXTRA-ORDINARY MINISTERS OF THE EUCHARIST**

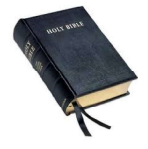
