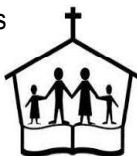

**Ash Wednesday (February 17<sup>th</sup>) and Good Friday (April 2<sup>nd</sup>) are days of FAST AND ABSTINENCE.** All other Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. The church law of abstinence applies to persons at age of 14. The law of fast applies to persons from their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday through their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday. The spirit of the law is that each individual Catholic finds his/her own way to make the penitential season a time for personal growth, through prayer, works of charity.
