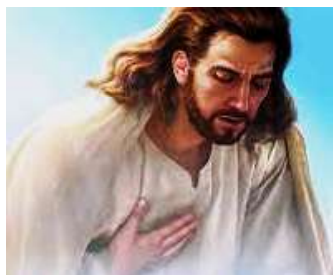


**THE ST. VINCENT DE PAUL TRIPARISH COMMUNITY PHARMACY**
