Dear Grade 7 & Grade 8 Parents-

What a year this has been. Due to the circumstances beyond our control, we were not able to attend Heartland Camp this year. In addition, the trip to Washington D.C. is much more expensive than the trip to camp. As a team and with the guidance of Mr. Kinley, we have decided that it would be extremely beneficial for both the incoming 7th and 8th graders to attend camp early in the year next year (this will be in the place of the Washington D.C. trip for the incoming 8th graders). We have been going to Heartland camp for well over 10 years now and any students who have ever gone, have nothing but amazing things to say. The students get to do so many fun activities that many of them have never experienced before. In addition, there are several team building activities that they will have the chance to experience that we feel could be extremely beneficial to them moving forward- both as individuals and also a group.

When: Tuesday September 28- Friday October 1 (we will leave ~ 9am on 9/28 and return ~ 1:30pm on 10/1 so drop off and pick up as usual)

Where: near Marengo, OH (see attached map)

Cost: The cost of the entire trip per student is \$220 which includes transportation, all meals, classes, and sleeping arrangements. Cost for each chaperone is \$100 per person.

Chaperones: ALL chaperones MUST have been fingerprinted (for background check) and have taken "Protecting God's Children" before we go to camp. This is a requirement by the Diocese of Columbus. We will need 8 male chaperones and 8 female chaperone's for this trip. Please let us know ASAP if you would be willing to chaperone.

***Fees for camp will be DUE BY SEPTEMBER 15th. If you are writing a check, please make the check out to St. Matthias School. After we return from camp, Heartland will bill the school and we will then pay for our trip in its entirety.**

***ALL Chaperones and Students need to have a medical form filled out by the time we leave (attached health forms provided in this packet)**
