Reading ends on April 12

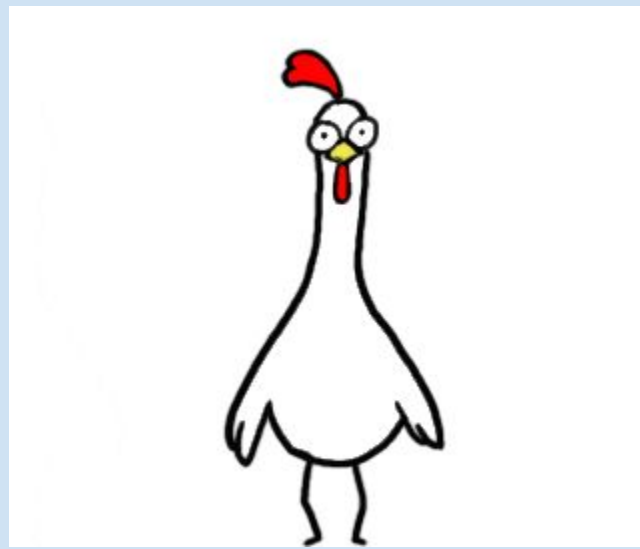




READ!

Keep track of your books and pages in the book log.

You'll have to turn this in!

GRADE	PAGE REQUIREMENTS BY GRADE <i>(How many pages does my child need to read to count as one book?)</i>
KINDERGARTEN	At parents' discretion.
FIRST	20 pages = 1 book
SECOND	30 pages = 1 book
THIRD	50 pages = 1 book
FOURTH	80 pages = 1 book
FIFTH	100 pages = 1 book

QUESTIONS?

- *Are you allowed to read Audio Books? If not, could you use an audio book with the actual book?*

IT IS ACCEPTABLE TO READ ALONG WITH AN AUDIO BOOK.

- *Are you allowed to reread books you've already read?*

TRY TO READ A NEW BOOK. IF YOU DON'T HAVE ANY NEW BOOKS AT ALL, RE-READING IS OKAY.

- *Can you read the Bible?*

YES AS LONG AS IT APPROPRIATE FOR YOUR READING LEVEL (for example, don't read your baby brother's board book Bible). CHECK WITH YOUR PARENT AND MAKE SURE YOU KNOW HOW MANY PAGES COUNT FOR ONE BOOK IN YOUR GRADE.

- *Are you allowed to continue to raise money after April 12th, the end of the reading portion of the Book-A-Thon?*

YOU CAN FUNDRAISE UNTIL APRIL 14. YOU MUST HAND IN YOUR PACKET AND MONEY ON APRIL 15.
