Prince of Peace has seven Commissions that help plan the direction and efforts of our Parish. These seven Commissions are:

- 1) Evangelization, 2) Faith Formation, 3) Family Life, 4) Justice & Peace,
- 5) Parish Life, 6) Stewardship, and, 7) Worship & Prayer.

Each month we will feature one of the Commissions as a way to inform Parish members what the Commission does and to encourage more involvement in one of our important Commissions. Some Commissions meet monthly, others less frequently – but each Commission serves a special purpose in accomplishing the mission of our Parish.

Each of the seven Commissions also selects one member who will serve on the Pastoral Council for a two-year term. The Commission Representative then reports on their activities along with the other representatives at the Pastoral Council meetings held five times during the year and to help advise the Pastor on matters of the Parish community.

FAMILY LIFE. The Family Life Commission meets twice a year and as needed at the Parish Office.

The purpose of the Family Life Commission is to establish opportunities that will facilitate the Christ-centered growth and well-being of the parish family. Commission members are the “think tank” to find new creative ways to provide these opportunities, especially during this pandemic.
