Jesus Sends Out the Disciples

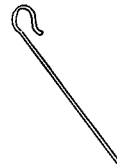


Jesus told 12 disciples to go out into the villages. What supplies could they take with them?

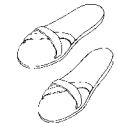

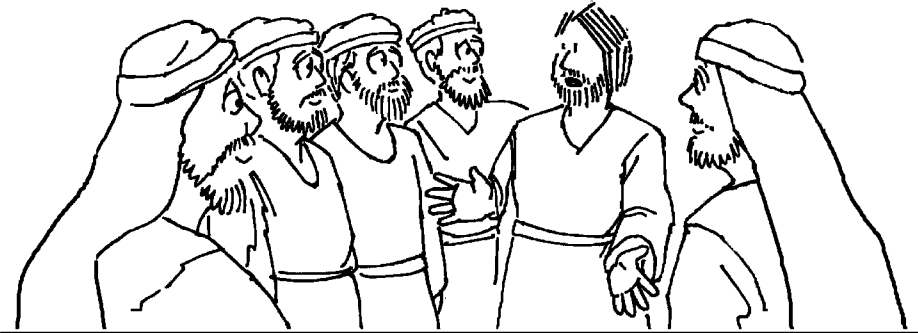
