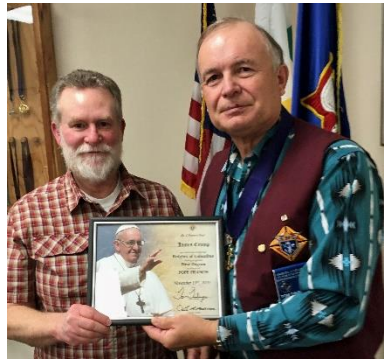
November Breakfast
