Wheelchair Distribution

Brothers All,

Our container of wheelchairs is on board a ship and has set sail for Mexico! We are in the planning stages for the trip. We are leaving Idaho on the 28th of May and returning on June

1st. Distributions of wheelchairs will be on the 29th and 30th of May and we will be visiting the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Metropolitan Cathedral on the 31st. I would estimate the cost of your flight and hotel to be around \$1,300. If you share a room, it could be cheaper. We will be making hotel arrangements in the next few weeks and I will let you know the details for the hotel as soon as possible.

I made my airline reservations this afternoon and I have attached airline details if you would like to make your reservations. The longer you wait, chances are they may sell out or who knows what will happen to the fares. The fare I quoted is as of today is with Delta Airlines and is based on round trip seating in the main cabin. Upgrades are available if you prefer. Also, if you want to use another

airline for whatever reason, plan to arrive in Mexico City on the 28th as close to 2:30 PM as possible and to depart from Mexico as close to 2:00 PM as possible. That way our ground transportation will be better coordinated.

This trip is open to anyone who wants to experience a wheelchair distribution and whoever wants to be in the real presence of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This includes family members, friends, parishioners, et al. Please pass this information on to all Idaho Councils. As a thought, Councils might consider sponsoring their Chaplains.

I will be compiling a list of those who want to travel, and the cutoff date will be May 1st. I strongly encourage you to consider making this trip. It is a life changing opportunity. Please let me know if you have any questions. Air travel information is given below.
