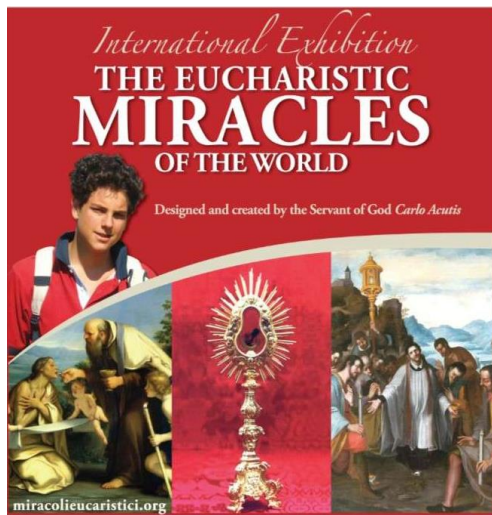
Unplanned – The Movie

The Eucharistic Miracles of the World Display



What is a Eucharistic Miracle?

Eucharistic miracles consist of unexplainable phenomena occurring after transubstantiation such as a host visibly transforming into human tissue, a host surviving fire, a host bleeding or the Eucharist alone providing sustenance to a human being for a prolonged period of time. In order to be considered a Eucharistic miracle, the event is investigated by a special task force before deciding it is worthy of belief. Stories of some of these miracles will be displayed at Pope St. Pius X.

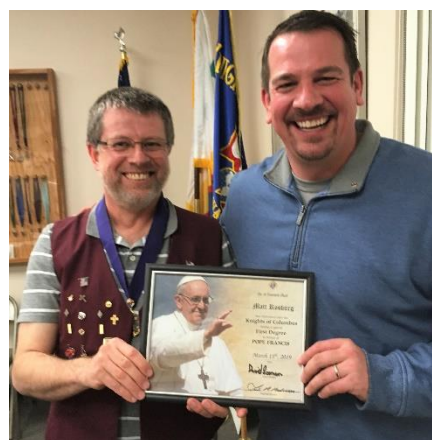
Watch bulletin and E-Messenger for other possible dates/times.
