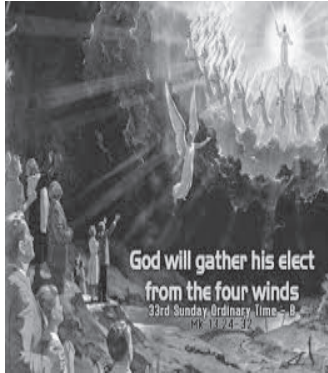

*When some people were speaking about how the temple was adorned with costly stones and votive offerings, Jesus said, "All that you see here...the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down."*

You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair on your head be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives."*
