



School Advisory Board Application for Membership 2021-2022

The mission of the St. Paul School Advisory Board is to promote and support a faith-based Catholic school environment that celebrates each child's personal, spiritual, academic, and social development. The Board provides advice and counsel to the Pastor and School Administrators on certain issues affecting the School.

The Board is composed of nine members, who serve staggered three-year terms. Board members must be currently registered and active parishioners of St. Paul Church (or another Catholic church with a child at St. Paul School) for no less than two (2) years, and regularly attend Mass. Active parishioners are those who fully participate in the worship and social life of the parish and the school, as well as provide financial support, to the best of their ability. **The Board must consist of at least six (6) members with a child attending St. Paul School. School employees and their immediate family members are not eligible to serve on the Board. No Board member may also sit on another governing body of the Parish.** Members must be willing to commit to attend SAB meetings which take place in the evenings once a month on the second Wednesday during the school year September-May and volunteer to support committee work.
