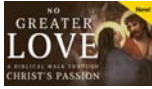

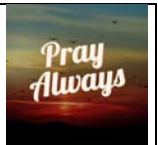
**YOUTH CAFÉ**

## SAINTS CYRIL AND METHODIUS

Our patrons are also Patron saints of Europe = February 14 is their Feast day. In 815 and 826 AD, the brothers Cyril and Methodius were born in Thessalonica, a city in what is now Greece but was then one of the main cities of the Eastern Roman Empire, commonly called Byzantine Empire. They were educated and knew how to speak both Greek and Slavonic, since many Slavic peoples then lived in that region as well. St. Cyril became a respected philosopher and taught at the "university" in Constantinople, the capital city of the Emperor. After early missions to Baghdad (Iraq), a Muslim capital, and to the Khazar kingdom (now in Ukraine and southern Russia), they were sent by the Emperor to the Old Slovak Kingdom of Great Moravia. They created an alphabet and translated the Bible and many books into the "old Slavonic" language. Thus, they began literary culture and education among our ancestors. In addition to evangelizing and educating, they also translated Mass prayers and wrote a Law code into the native language. Facing challenges from other priests, they went to Rome to defend themselves before the Pope. The Bishop of Rome welcomed them and officially approved their mission. They celebrated Mass in the great Roman basilicas in the language of our ancestors, Old Slavonic. While in Rome, St. Cyril felt his end coming and became a monk. His dying prayer was for our ancestors and for his brother to continue their work. St. Cyril died on February 14, 869. The Pope ordained St. Methodius an Archbishop and some of their disciples as priests and deacons. He continued to face challenges but endured faithfully. St. Methodius died on April 6, 885. Their disciples, including the first Slovak Saint Gorazd, faced exile but continued the mission among the southern Slavic peoples in Bulgaria and Macedonia. St. Methods named St. Gorazda as his successor. St. Pope John Paul II declared Sts. Cyril and Methodius to be co-patrons of Europe, as their legacy impacted the Slavic half of the continent. Their lives were an example of unity among all of the Christians and evangelization to all peoples.



## Svätí Cyril a Metod

Naši patroni sú tiež patrónmi Európy = 14. február je ich sviatok. V rokoch 815 a 826 sa svätí bratia Cyril a Metod narodili v Solúne, mesto v dnešnom Grécku, ale v tom čase bolo jedným z hlavných miest Východnej Rímskej ríše, bežne nazývaného Byzantská ríša. Boli vzdelaní a vedeli hovoriť po grécky aj slovansky, pretože v tomto regióne tiež žilo mnoho slovanských národov. Sv. Cyril sa stal uznávaným filozofom a vyučoval na „univerzite“ v hlavnom meste Konštantínopole. Po skorých misiách v Bagdade (Irak), moslimskom hlavnom meste, a do kráľovstva Khazar (dnešná Ukrajina a južné Rusko) ich cisár poslal do Starého slovenského kráľovstva Veľkej Moravy. Vytvorili abecedu a preložili Bibliu a mnoho kníh do "staroslovenčiny". Začali tak literárnu kultúru a vzdelávanie medzi našimi predkami. Okrem evanjelizácie a vzdelávania tiež preložili modlitby na svätú omšu a napísali zákon. Kôli kritike od iných kňazov odišli do Ríma, aby sa bránili pred pápežom. Rímsky biskup ich privítal a oficiálne schválil ich poslanie. Slávili sv. omšu vo veľkých rímskych bazilikách v jazyku našich predkov. Počas svojho pobytu v Ríme Sv. Cyril cítil, že sa blíži jeho koniec a stal sa mníchom. Jeho umierajúca modlitba bola za našich predkov a za brata, aby pokračovali vo svojej práci. Sv. Cyril zomrel 14. februára 869. Pápež vysvätil sv. Metoda za arcibiskupa a niektorých ich učeníkov kňazov a diaconov. Stále čelil odporu franských kňazov, ale verne vydržal. Sv. Metod zomrel 6. apríla 885. Ich učeníci, vrátane prvého slovenského svätca, Sv. Gorazda, čelili vyhnanstvu, ale pokračovali v misii medzi juhoslovanskými národmi v Bulharsku a Macedónsku. Sv. Metod menoval Sv. Gorazda za svojho nástupcu. Sv. Pápež Ján Pavol II. vyhlásil Svätých Cyrila a Metoda za spolu-patrónov Európy, pretože ich odkaz ovplyvnil slovanskú polovicu kontinentu. Ich životy boli príkladom jednoty medzi všetkými kresťanmi a evanjelizácie všetkých.
