FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN for Sunday, October 24, 2021

On October 18, Bishop Fabbro promulgated a COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for all clergy, employees, staff, and volunteers engaged in the ministry of the Church. This policy has been enacted to continue to provide safe places of worship and work, celebrate the sacraments, and carry out our religious duties and responsibilities for the common good. As Pope Francis himself said: "Being vaccinated is an act of love. Each one of us can make his or her own small gesture of love....no matter how small, love is always grand. Small gestures for a better future".

It is my prayer that this policy, while temporary for as long as necessary, will continue to unite us as a family of parishes mindful of our goal of being a mission-oriented church, loving our neighbour, and working together for the greater good as disciples of Jesus.

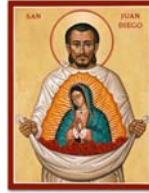
