Pastor's Message - Sixth Week of Easter

"Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him." (John 14:23)

In today's gospel, Jesus assures his disciples of his abiding presence with them even when He is gone. He asks everyone to "keep his word."

So how often do we read the Scriptures on a given day? Do we pray with the Scriptures and allow the Spirit of God to help us discern God's design for each one of us?

Jesus calls us to be responsible stewards of God's gifts of time, talent, and treasure. Likewise, Jesus calls every Christian community to be accountable and transparent in dealing with temporal and spiritual gifts entrusted to her care, including an openness to the promptings of the Holy Spirit in and through the formation.

One pillar of stewardship is formation – the willingness to deepen one's faith and relationship with Jesus in the context of a community. Stewardship is learning from the word of Christ, receiving and sharing His peace, enlightened by the Holy Spirit in prayerful discernment of God's holy will.

Through the help of catechists, mentors, and spiritual directors, every learning Christian will know they are not alone in their journey.

Our faith formation programs and workshops offer only a minimum of help for our community. What is essential are personal readings, reflections and the resulting growth of embracing the fullness of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.
