Minimum to raise per family | | <p><u>FINANCIAL AWARDS/TUITION ASSISTANCE – online applications due by June 1, 2020.</u></p> Financial Awards for TUITION ONLY are available for qualifying families with students in grades K-12 . The application, called the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment, costs \$35 to complete; it opens on February 1, 2020, and must be submitted online by June 1, 2020. Financial awards are given on a first-come first-served basis. Shiner Catholic School utilizes FACTS Tuition Management Company for: (1) determining the financial needs of families; and (2) establishing payment plans. <u>Both are offered on one platform; set-up access is within the Online Enrollment process. Once a FACTS account is established, choose Set-Up a Payment Plan for monthly drafts or choose Start Application to apply for financial aid.</u> The financial aid form can also be accessed through the school website under the Admissions tab. |
