

## **COVID-19 FACE COVERING POLICY 2020-21**

Students will wear face coverings at all times while in any building at Shiner Catholic School. Face covering are defined as non-medical grade disposable face coverings (over the nose and mouth), or full face shields to protect eyes, nose, and mouth. Examples include surgical masks, cloth masks, neck gaiters, etc.

When students are in science labs and social distancing is not possible, students will wear face masks and face shields for extra protection.

Athletic policies regarding face coverings that were developed by the University Interscholastic League (UIL) and the Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools (TAPPS) will be followed for athletic practices, athletic competitions, physical education, and recess. Please see the Athletic COVID-19 Plan for greater details.

When students are outside, they can remove their face coverings when they are 6 feet apart from their neighbor.

When students knowingly disregard the face covering policy, the following consequences will occur:

- 1.) Student will receive a written warning.
- 2.) Parents will be called and student will be sent home for the remainder of the day.
- 3.) Student will receive one four hour Saturday School detention.
- 4.) Student will be sent home to learn virtually. During virtual learning, students will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities.
