The application, called the FACTS Grant &amp; Aid Assessment, costs \$35 to complete; it opened on February 15, 2021, and must be submitted online by June 1, 2021. Financial awards are given on a first-come, first-served basis. Shiner Catholic School utilizes FACTS Tuition Management Company for: (1) determining the financial needs of families; and (2) establishing payment plans. <u>Both are offered on one platform; set-up access is within the Online Enrollment process.
