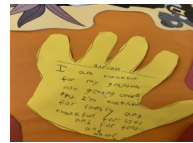

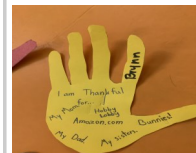

Dear Parents of St. John School:

St. John the Evangelist School will continue with in-person learning for as long as possible. Logan-Hocking Schools has put out information that they may be going virtual soon. St. John will not be following Logan-Hocking Schedules when they are announced when it comes to distance or in-person learning. Therefore, should Logan-Hocking declare distance this Friday, St. John will be in-person for Monday, November, 23 and Tuesday, November 24. If there is no transportation those days will be car days. There is no school on Wednesday, November 25 as announced last week. (Wellness Day).

We plan to be in-person on Tuesday, December 1, and throughout the month of December. We will go distance-learning if: 1) We have a teacher test positive for COVID. 2) We have a student test positive. St. John School Community is very close and we have multiple children from the same family in multiple grades. An announcement would be made on Remind and our Website. The school would automatically go two weeks on Distance-Learning and then we would reassess the spread. We would then go back in-person if possible.

We would, also, need to go virtual if there is an Ohio State Mandate and/or The Hocking County Health Dept. would tell us to go virtual. Should we go to distance learning, teachers and staff will report to the building and conduct instruction from their classrooms. Instruction would include: worksheets, textbooks, workbooks, reading materials, as well as online instruction. More about this later.

I ask that families continue to be smart about all the mitigations that we have been told that will help prevent the spread of the virus. You make it possible for us to stay in-person. Please help us to continue to achieve this goal.
