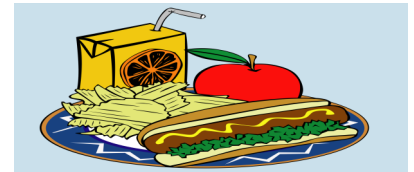
Great News !

The USDA has granted a waiver to St. John School. The waiver that was granted, will provide every student at St. John School a free lunch from September 08,2020 through December 31,2020.

Students will have to start paying again on January 01,2021. If you feel your family qualifies for free or reduced lunches, please still fill out the free and reduced lunch forms, that was sent out the first day of school in your blue folders. That way the transition back to payments will be smooth.

If you have made a payment for lunches this year, you may request your money back or leave it in your child's account for use in January — May of 2021.
