Dear Parents,

Do you participate in Kroger Community rewards? If not, please link your Kroger account to Saint John School. It is the simplest way to give (at no extra cost to you) to our school.

We enrolled in the Kroger Community rewards program in 2009 and receive quarterly checks. Our first check was \$2900 and we have received over \$42,000 dollars in the past 11 years from Kroger! Today, our quarterly checks only average around \$550. My personal last quarterly contribution was over \$25 (\$100/yr!).

We are the last local school to send our 5th and 6th graders to Washington D.C. and this money has covered 100% of the trips. However, our account is dwindling and future classes may not have 100% coverage if we don't increase participation.

Kroger donates a percentage of every dollar you spend back to your community organization. Every time you use your Kroger card, you are giving back without even thinking about it! Enrollment only takes a few minutes.

Lock Down vs. Lock Out

St. John school is notified immediately when LHSD is on a Lock Down or a Lock Out. A **lock out** means all the outside doors are locked and no one enters the building or leaves the building. A **lock down** means all the doors are locked with nobody in or

out plus the teachers lock their classrooms doors. St. John School is already on a Lock Out everyday. All our doors are always locked and because of COVID 19 we do not let people in the school. The only difference on a normal day we are able to go outside.

For preschool parents please come down to the door to pick up your student. They will be kept inside until you are able to be at their side. We will not be walking them up the stairs.

Students will be called by number and released and put in car. Proceed home.

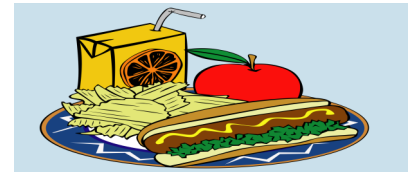
Great News !

The USDA has granted a waiver to St. John School. The waiver that was granted, will provide every student at St. John School a free lunch from September 08,2020 through December 31,2020.

*Students will have to start paying again on January 01,2021. If you feel your family qualifies for free or reduced lunches, **please** still fill out the free and reduced lunch forms, that was sent out the first day of school in your blue folders. That way the transition back to payments will be smooth.*

If you have made a payment for lunches this year, you may request your money back or leave it in your child's account for use in January — May of 2021.
