Perpetual Adoration for Lent

Sign up has begun for all night or perpetual Adoration during the six weeks of Lent. It is best if there are at least two adorers each hour. The ideal situation would be to have our parishioners take one hour each week for a total of six hours. If there is optimal participation, the schedule will be quickly filled. The grace and blessings of participation in Eucharistic Adoration will more than make up for the small loss of sleep sacrificed to offer that hour each week. If you are concerned about security, please know that only the east door is open after 4:30 PM and remember that you will be in the presence of our Lord!

Please take advantage of this wonderful time of quiet prayer with our Lord present in the Eucharist. **Please note you are signing up for late night and early morning hours – 9:00 PM thru 6:00 AM.** The daytime hours are covered.
