**Divine Mercy Sunday**

In a decree dated August 3, 2003, Pope John Paul II granted a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (sacramental confession – Lenten confession meets this requirement, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved on the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus. We will be praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet at St. Patrick’s at 3:00 PM on Sunday, April 28.

The St. Wenceslaus weekend Mass schedule will return to normal, effective April 27/28, 2019. Masses will be offered Saturday at 4:00 PM and Sunday at 7:30 AM and 9:30 AM. The last Sunday 4:00 PM Mass will be offered Easter Sunday April 21, 2019.
