**KC Council Soup for Seminarians Update:** This year, we have raised \$4,883.25 in our soup sales. St. Patrick's Parish in Dickinson contributed \$2,724.25 and St Joseph's Parish in Killdeer contributed \$2,159.00. We have been able to do nine RSVP scholarships to our men in formation from the soup sales.

The program has outperformed our expectations and our two year totals are staggering; with the last two full years combined we have raised \$10,101.25 for our seminarians and have a combined 420 hours of man power put into the "Soup for Seminarians" project. It truly warms my heart to see how our two communities have supported this program for our future priests.
