Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 26. Masses at St. Patrick's will be at 7:00 AM, 8:30 AM & 5:30 PM.

Stations of the Cross followed by the Divine Mercy Chaplet will be Fridays at 7:00 PM.

Lenten regulations for the Diocese of Bismarck are as follows:

● Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.

● In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to ones needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. These minimal penitential practices should not be lightly excused.

**Perpetual Adoration for Lent**

Sign up has begun for all night or perpetual Adoration during the six weeks of Lent. It is best if there are at least two adorers each hour. The ideal situation would be to have our parishioners take one hour each week for a total of six hours. If there is optimal participation, the schedule will be quickly filled. The grace and blessings of participation in Eucharistic Adoration will more than make up for the small loss of sleep sacrificed to offer that hour each week.

The sign-up sheets can be found in the back of the church or you may call the Parish Office. Please take advantage of this wonderful time of quiet prayer with our Lord present in the Eucharist. **Please note you are signing up for late night and early morning hours – 9:00 PM thru 6:00 AM.** The daytime hours are covered.
