First Communion is scheduled for September 20 at noon. As there is limited seating in the church due to social distancing, we are asking that only family attend this Mass. Thank you.

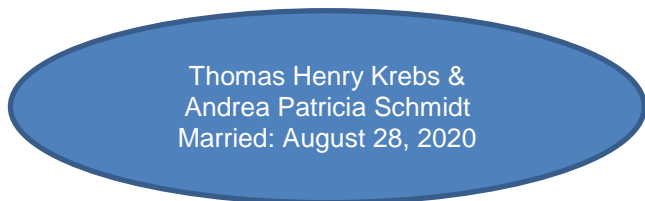
**Religious Education Update**

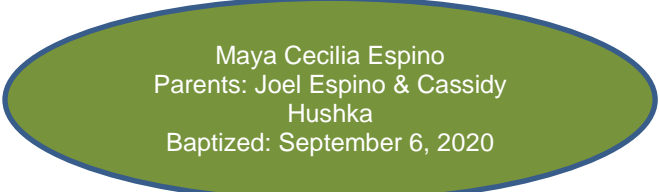
