Christmas Flower Fund: Remember your loved ones
this Christmas season with a contribution to the Christmas
Flower Fund. Place the names of those you wish to
remember, along with your donation in the flower
envelope, which you received in the December envelope
packet and drop it in the Sunday collection basket during
Advent. If you are participating in Stewardship list the
names of those you wish to remember and drop it in the
collection basket.

Reminder: According to Internal Revenue Service
Regulations, **contributions need to be dated and
received before January 1, 2021** to receive credit for the
year 2020. If you have a year-end contributions please
drop it off in the weekend collection or at the parish office
before 4:00 PM on December 31. The CARES Act
(Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security) created 2
temporary changes to the tax treatment of charitable
donations. For those no longer itemizing their charitable
giving, the CARES Act allows taxpayers to deduct
donations to our Church of up to \$300 on their 2020
federal tax return, even though they take the standard
deduction. Married-filing jointly taxpayers will get an
above-the-line deduction of up to \$600. For more
