Sunday Mass will be live-streamed on Facebook at 10:00 AM. Daily Mass will no longer be live-streamed.

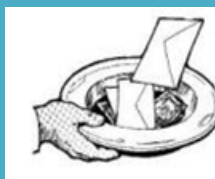
