Parish Rebates (Updated July 2021) –MHT/yfb

As per the Centennial Campaign Policies approved by the Priest Advisory Committee (PAC), parish rebates (based on cash received) are to be provided to parishes six (6) months after the completion of a Bloc. After the initial rebate is remitted, forthcoming, additional rebates are to be remitted on a semi-annual basis.

***Centennial Campaign rebate figures were provided by/obtained from the Office of Accounting, and are accurate as of June 30, 2021.**

The Office of Accounting deposits monies (rebate) into each respective parish's Cooperative Loan and Deposit Program (CDLP) - Centennial Account. If a loan balance exists, monies are applied toward the loan balance.
