## **School Supplies:**

## **Summer Requirements:**

The required reading lists and IXL math minutes (20 minutes a day, for a total of 60 minutes per week are available on the school website: <https://school.stpiusxsa.org/summer-reading-and-math-assignments>. This is a test grade for incoming 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. If your student does not remember their IXL information, please contact the school office.

The English/Reading classes will discuss the required book and be graded on that book during the first week of school. For any other books that are read, the students will do a book report to hand in the first day of school. This is a test grade for incoming 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.

## **Orientation:**

Our Orientation Night will be held on Monday, August 12, 2019 from 5:00pm – 6:30pm. This will be a chance to meet the faculty and staff, drop off school supplies in the classrooms, learn about our PTC, sign up for Extended Day, etc...

## **School Day:**

Our first day of school will be **Wednesday, August 14, 2019**. We will not attend Mass the first day of school, instead we will attend as a school on Thursday, August 15<sup>th</sup> for the Feast of the Assumption. Our school day begins at 7:50am. Teachers are on campus starting at 7:00am and our PreK-3 and PreK-4 students will gather in the Early Morning Center multipurpose room beginning at 7:00am. Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students gather in the SPX Cafeteria before adjourning to their respective classrooms at 7:40am.

Our PreK-3, PreK-4, and Kindergarten students are dismissed at 3:00pm, while our 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are released at 3:15pm. We offer an Extended Day program which is an extension of the school day from 3:00pm until 6:00pm. Students who are not picked up by 3:30pm will be sent to Extended Day.
