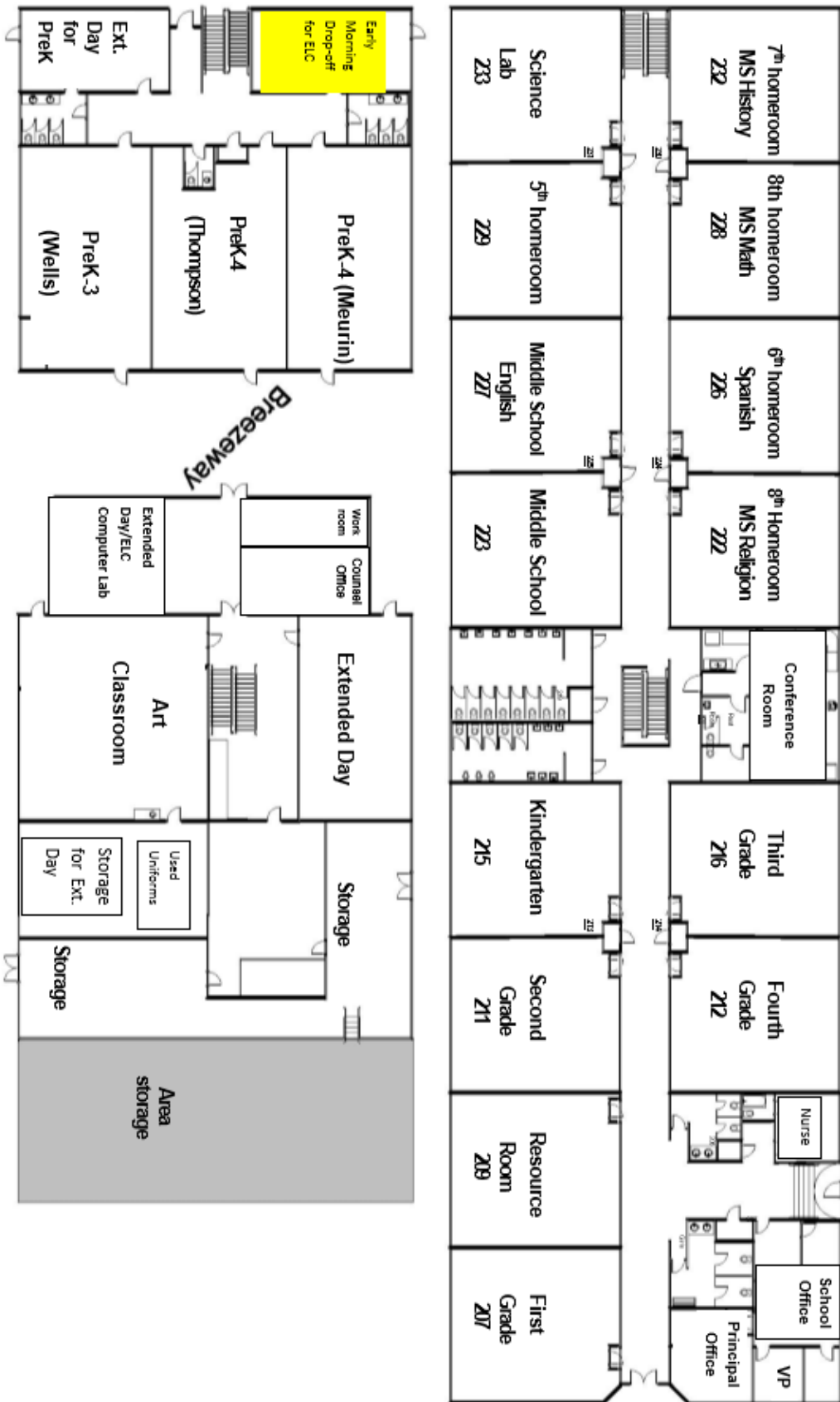
School Clinic News
