If you have any Legos you are willing to donate, please send them to school.

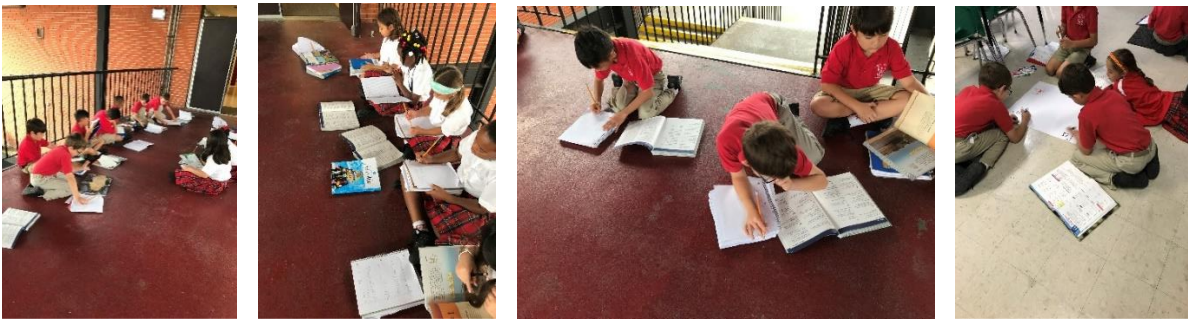
