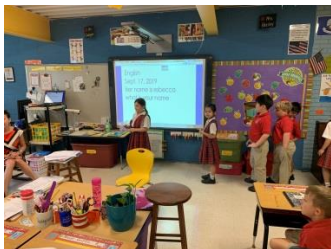
- Go to www.schoolstore.net and sign up using our school ID: 120214
