St. Paul's Church (Black River, N.Y.) and St. Rita's Roman Catholic Church (Deferiet, N.Y.), having made separate Petitions for merger of these churches into St. Paul's Church (Black River, N.Y.), pursuant to Religious Corporation Law § 13, and upon consideration of said Petitions, each with annexed thereto (1) the Plan of Merger agreed upon and entered into by both churches, (2) the Unanimous Written Consent of the Trustees and the Diocese of Ogdensburg, the governing body having jurisdiction over the churches, and (3) statements showing all properties and liabilities, as well as the

amount and source of annual income of each church, all in support of the merger, and both churches being of the same Roman Catholic denomination, and such Petitions having come on to be regularly heard and due deliberation having been had thereon, and upon the motion of Kevin J. O'Brien, Esq., attorney for Petitioners, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Petitions for the Merger of the petitioning churches are **GRANTED** and the churches are merged upon the terms set forth in their agreement; and it is further


ORDERED, that the name of the merged corporation shall be St. Paul's Church (Black River, N.Y.); and it is further

ORDERED, that the first trustees of the consolidated corporation shall be the Most Reverend Terry R. LaValley, Reverend Joseph A. Morgan, Reverend Robert L. Decker, Mr. John Kiechle and Mrs. Patricia Turpin; and it is further


ORDERED, that the method of selection of successor trustees will be that set forth in Religious Corporation Law § 91 and the date for the first corporate meeting shall be July 1, 2019.

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
